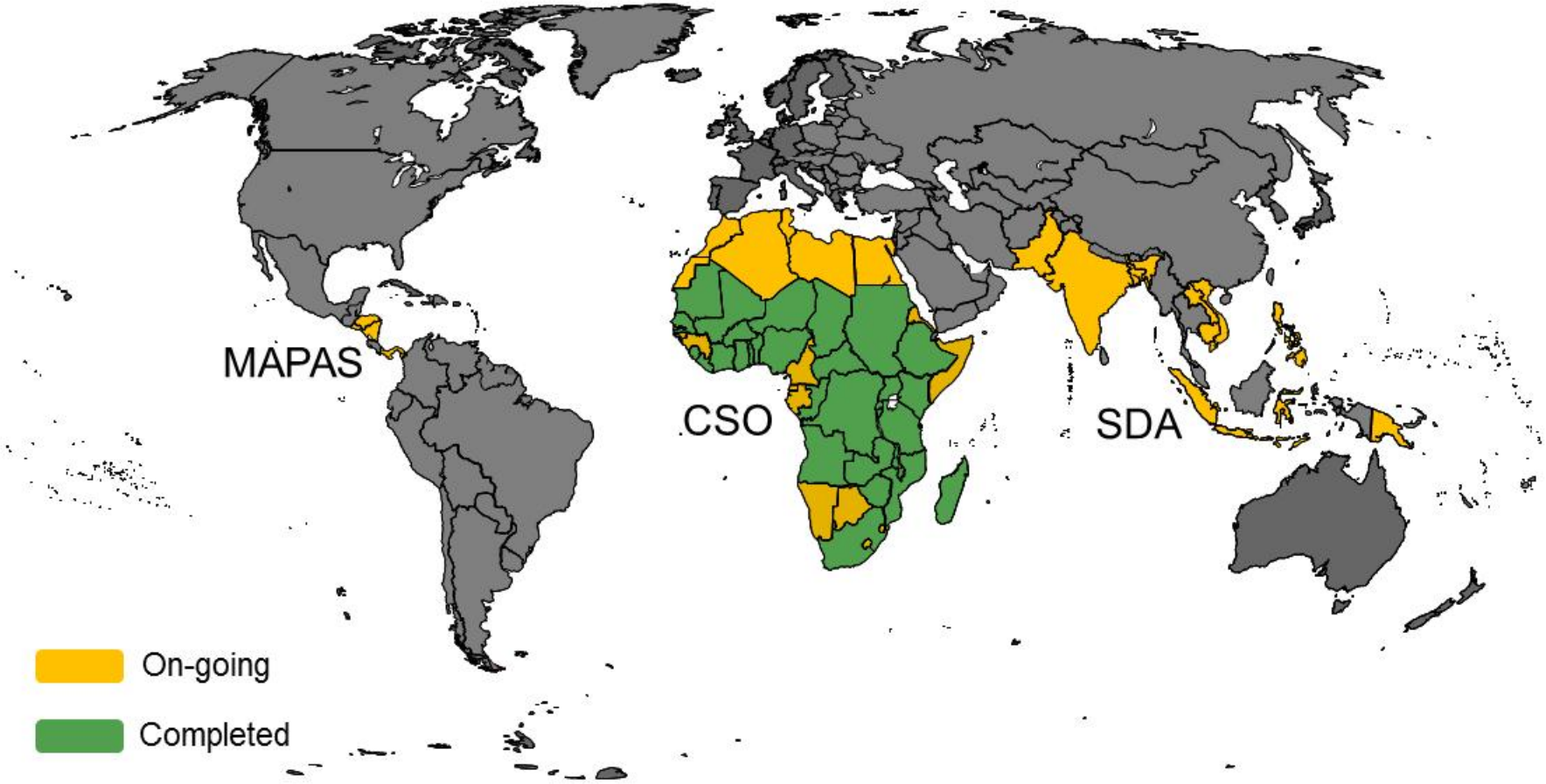

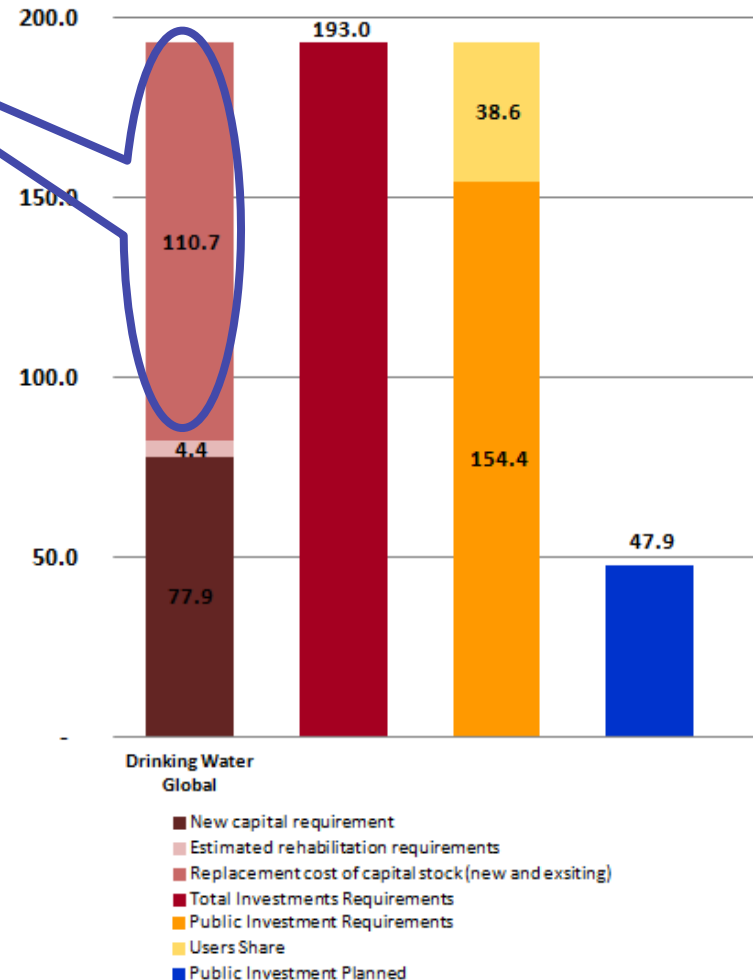
# Coverage of CSOs, MAPAS and SDAs

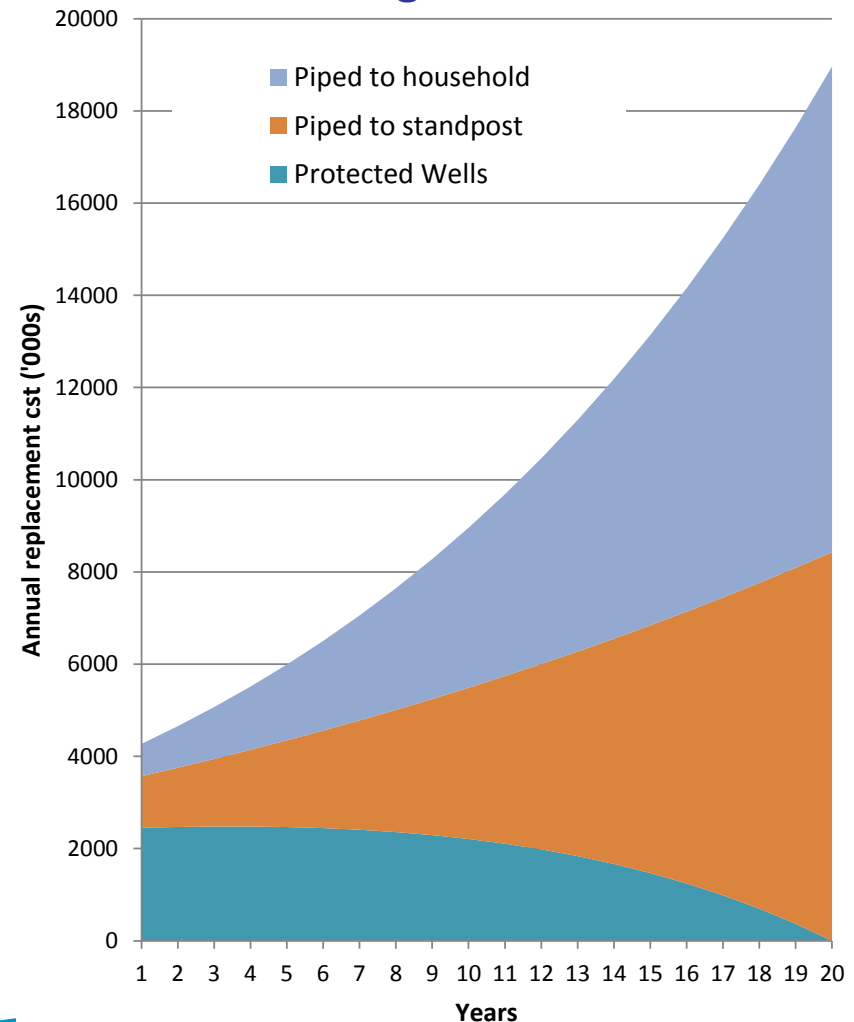
## Planned vs required funding

... but not developing or sustaining pillars

## ...but raises trade-offs

- Light vs Heavy
  - Method development is adding functions and complexity
  - Should there be a round of simplification?
  
- Country relevance vs Global consistency
  - Indicator relevance – e.g. Donor coordination – can it be generalized?
  - Indicator specificity – e.g ODF villages – Is this now an industry standard?
  - Elements of method get embedded in country systems but rarely wholesale
  - How to get standardized aggregatable indicators globally?
  
- Audit vs Participatory process
  - More participation = more country interest and use
  - Challenging in countries not willing to be participatory
  - Value in documenting status BUT catalytic ambition should be scaled back

# Where next, when next

- **Africa:** Integrate CSO and IBNET indicators into AUC-AMCOW M&E-Task Force – no CSO3
- **LAC:** + Haiti second round to revisit progress of existing countries.
- **EAP:** Decentralized level (Philippines, Indonesia Vietnam) + Myanmar
- **South Asia:** More states in India
- **Next rounds:** 3-5 year intervals
